PLEASE READ AND INITIAL ALL AREAS LISTED BELOW

_____ **ALL FLOATS AND PARADE PARTICIPANTS WILL BE TOLD AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION THAT IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY, THEY SHOULD**

- a. **MOVE TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE ROAD IF TOLD BY A PARADE VOLUNTEER**
- b. **ATTEMPT TO LEAVE ENOUGH ROOM BETWEEN THEIR GROUP AND THE GROUP IN FRONT OF THEM TO COMPLETELY MOVE TO THE RIGHT LANE (TRAILER AND ALL)**
- c. **STAY STOPPED AND IN THE RIGHT LANE UNTIL THEY ARE DIRECTED TO CONTINUE BY A PARADE VOLUNTEER.**

_____ **For safety reasons, we do not allow candy to be thrown from any parade vehicles. Candy may be gently tossed by people walking with your group (they cannot be riding on and/or driving in the parade vehicle).**

_____ **A group may stop forward motions for performances along the parade route, but a stop may not exceed 5 minutes in length. A space of 50 feet between each group will be enforced. All groups are required to close gap between groups when instructed to do so by a parade official. A stop exceeding 5 minutes in length or failure to follow a parade official's instruction to close gap will result in the group being ineligible for a prize.**

Parade winners will be contacted at the earliest possible convenience. Participants can also return to judging area to inquire about prizes.
